Ideas to do at home: Fun with Boxes

Have boxes left over from the holidays. It's a great opportunity to reuse them in different ways!

or

Have lots of **small boxes**? Create different size blocks by stuffing them with paper and taping them up. Build towers and knock them down.

or

Have **medium** size **boxes**? Put different items inside and your infant takes them out. Put them back in and ask to find the items again.

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Have **large boxes**? Cut both sides off and make a tunnel. Let your infant colour the sides with markers. Then encourage your infant to crawl through.

Other ideas: vehicle, house, etc.
