When your Child is Sick

Keeping your child home from childcare when you are busy with work or school can be a difficult situation. However, if your child has the telltale signs of an approaching illness, please don't risk infecting the rest of the centre! To prevent the spread of germs, we recommend the following steps.



- 1. Review our sick child policy. If your child has a fever, vomiting or diarrhea, they should not be here! If your child develops these symptoms throughout the day, we hope that you will be here as soon as possible to pick them up and remain away from the centre for at least 24-48 hours symptom free.
- Inform the centre when your child is sick. This allows us to inform other families and staff which increases communal awareness. It is also beneficial to report to your doctor if certain symptoms are present in the centre.
