Skills we will be Working On:

Pre-reading Skills

- Repeating words, recognition of the first letter of their names.
- Learning concepts on, under, in, on, beside

Math Skills

- Counting from 1 to 10 in other languages
- Size differentiation – big and small objects

Motor Skills

- Practise holding and using scissors, opening containers, and peeling stickers

Self Help Skills

- Practice pulling on shoes/boots, holding the table and pushing feet in
- Practice pushing the chair into the table after mealtimes/play activities

Social Skills

- Practice conversations with friends and educators using simple sentences.
- Practice using please, thank you, can I, may I please?”

How Does Learning Happen?
