*April 1st – Easter Monday (*centre will be closed*)*

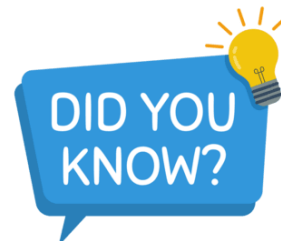
What we are working on:

As you may have noticed, we have been spending a lot of time working on toilet training! Majority of our class is in the progress of toilet training whether they are getting familiar with our friend toilet or they are getting ready to say goodbye to diapers for good. Here are some tips and tricks for helping your child at home:

1. Get a child sized seat addition or potty that is all theirs! This helps them become more comfortable with the concept of toileting.
2. Make a sticker chart – every time they use the toilet, add a sticker.
3. Keep toileting consistent. Have them sit on the toilet at the same times throughout the day so they familiarize themselves with the routine.
4. Don't be discouraged! Your child may still have a wet diaper even if they sometimes use the toilet. They are still learning to regulate their bodies and have lots of time to learn this particular skill.

International Women's Day:

This day is a global day to recognize and celebrate women's and girls' social, economic, cultural, and political achievements. It's also a time to raise awareness of the progress made towards achieving gender equality and the work remaining to be done.

Observations:

There is lots to see throughout the day. This month we will be working on closely observing our environments using language to extend our play experiences.

Some things we can observe are:

- Plants, trees, animals and signs of spring (3.2 vocabulary: using descriptive language)
- What our friends are doing (1.1 observing and imitating, 2.5 initiating activities)
- Images we recognize in books and on posters like animals, vehicles, alphabets, numbers and more (4.7 root skills of literacy, 4.8 memory, 4.9 labeling)
