- practicing using a spoon during lunch
- playing simple “turn taking” games with balls
- imitating actions and sounds of animals
- responding to simple requests
- self- help skills removing a hat, shoes

Ashley and Vina visit our infant room once a week and Ruth once a month to sing songs, tell stories and create different gross motor experiences for the infants.

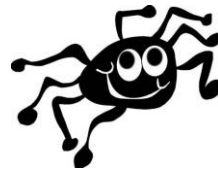
