National Day of Truth and Reconciliation:

National Day for Truth and Reconciliation happens every year on September 30th. The day honours the children who never returned home and Survivors of residential schools, as well as their families and communities.

Orange Shirt Day is an Indigenous-led grassroots commemorative day intended to promote the concept of "Every Child Matters". The orange shirt is a symbol of the stripping away of culture, freedom and self-esteem experienced by Indigenous children over generations.

This year National Day of Truth and Reconciliation will fall on a Monday. We will
