Skills we will be working on:

From 6 – 12 months

- cruising/strength
- walking with support
- sitting without support
- exploring different senses
- using palmar grasp
- waving or responding to HI and BYE
- playing simple "peek-a-boo" game

From 12 to 18 months

- "dancing" to music
- pointing to familiar things
- practicing to use a spoon during lunch
- playing simple "turn taking" games with balls
- imitating actions and sounds of animals
- responding to simple requests
- self- help skills, i.e. removing a hat, shoes

Program enhancement:

Ashley and Victoria visit our infant room once a week and Ruth once a month to sing songs, tell stories and create different gross motor experiences for the infants.

Many soldiers in battle fell.

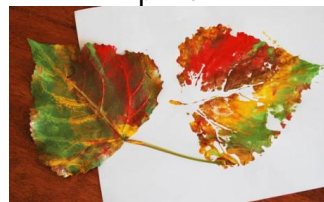
Poppy Poppy what should we know?
