From 8 to 12 months

- crawling to get a toy
- sitting without support

From 12 to 18 months

- stand up with support
- pick up food to eat
- increasing strength in different muscles - "dancing" to music
- pointing to familiar things
- practicing using a spoon during lunch
- playing simple turn taking games with balls
- imitate actions and sounds of animals
- responding to simple requests
- self- help skills removing mittens, hat
- recognize own belongings
