

## Math Skills:

- Sorting objects by one or more properties
- Using bigger than and smaller than to describe objects

#### **Motor Skills:**

- Practise throwing and catching balls
- Working on skipping/galloping skills

### Self-Help Skills:

- Practise undoing and doing up buttons
- Working on keeping our cubbies organized

#### **Science Skills:**

- Mixing primary colours to make secondary colours
- Describing similarities in events

### **Social Skills:**

- Practise to using our words with peers
- Sharing and turn taking
