### Skills we will be working on:

#### From 6 – 12 months

- cruising/strength
- walking with support
- exploring different senses
- using palmar grasp
- waving or responding to HI and BYE
- playing simple “peak-a-boo” game

#### From 12 to 18 months

- “dancing” to music
- pointing to familiar things
- practicing using a spoon during lunch
- playing simple “turn taking” games with balls
- imitating actions and sounds of animals
- responding to simple requests
- self- help skills removing mitten, hat, shoes

### Ideas to do at home:

Infants exhibit a strong affinity for engaging in physical movement in response to music and familiar melodies. At home, consider playing music and dancing with your child, as this activity serves as an excellent opportunity to promote their gross motor development, encourage physical activity, and foster meaningful interactions.



### Rhyme of the month:

Jack in the box
