Outdoor idea to stay active: Spring Scavenger Hunt



Skills we will be working on:

From 6 – 12 months

- cruising/strength
- walking with support
- exploring different senses
- using palmar grasp
- waving or responding to HI and BYE
- playing simple “peak-a-boo” game

From 12 to 18 months

- “dancing” to music
- pointing to familiar things
- practicing to use a spoon during lunch
- playing simple “turn taking” games with balls
- imitating actions and sounds of animals
- responding to simple requests
- self- help skills removing jacket, hat, shoes

Idea to do at home and outdoor: Baby pool (inflated or plastic)

You can put different things in a pool (small balls, cut pool noodles, 2” + pom poms, unroller receipt paper...). Let children explore texture, colors and even dumping them out. You can also hide one different item under the content and ask your child to find it. Great sensory and physical learning experience. Supervise the play.
