Enriching the Program:

As part of our program enhancement, Anna and Ruth come into the room on a weekly basis to do literacy, music and movement (read a story, sing a song/play instruments and dance).

Skills we will work towards:

For the month of April, we are working towards strengthening our fine motor skills. We will focus on incorporating different creative and cognitive activities that will enhance our fine-motor, eye coordination and dexterity.

- Building towers with blocks, toddlers can work on stacking various sizes and colors of blocks to help improve hand-eye coordination and understanding size differentiation and balance.
- 2) Simple puzzles: using puzzles can help build problem solving skills, matching and hand eye coordination
- Stringing beads: Using large beads and strings can help toddlers practice threading which is great for improving grip strength as well as hand-eye coordination.

Science experiment

A great and simple science activity for toddlers is "Color Mixing with Water!" Here's how to do it:

What you'll need:

- 3 clear cups or bowls
- Water
- Food coloring
- A few spoons or pipettes
- White plate or tray (optional)

How to do the activity:

- 1. Fill each cup with water.
- 2. Add a few drops of different food coloring to each cup.
- Observe what happens when colors mix!
 For example, red + yellow = orange, yellow
 + blue = green, and red + blue = purple.
- 4. Talk about the new colors they created.
- 5. Toddlers can take turns and see what happens when they mix them. Most of all, have fun and discuss the steps when doing the activity!
