Program enhancement

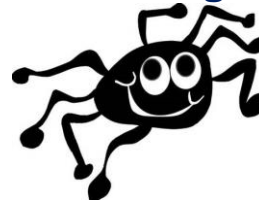
Victoria, Ashley and Ruth join our Infant Room once a week to sing songs, tell stories, and create a variety of physical experiences for the children.
