Skills we will be working on:

From 2-5 months

- beginning to control head movement
- reaching out and grasping objects or toys
- rolling from front to back
- learning to sit without support
- imitating speech sounds, such as "baba" and "dada"

From 6 – 12 months

- cruising/strength
- walking with educator's support
- exploring different senses
- using palmar grasp
- waving or responding to HI and BYE
- playing simple "peek-a-boo" game

From 12 to 18 months

- "dancing" to music
- pointing to familiar things
- practicing using a spoon during lunch
- playing simple "taking turn" games with balls
- imitating actions and sounds of animals'
- responding to simple requests
- self- help skills removing mitten, hat, and shoes
