Skills we will be working on:

From 2-5 months

- beginning to control head movement
- reaching out and grasping toys or objects
- rolling from front to back
- learning to sit without support
- imitating speech sounds such as “baba”
“dada”

From 6-12 months

- cruising/strength
- walking with educator’s support
- exploring different senses
- using palmar grasp
- waving and responding to “Hi” and “Bye”
- playing simple “peek-a-boo” game

From 12-18 months

- “dancing” to music
- pointing to familiar things
- practicing using a spoon during lunch
- playing simple “turn taking” games
- imitating actions and sounds of animals
- responding to simple requests
- self-help skills, removing mitten, hat
