## Skills we will be working on:

### **Gross motor:**

- Coordination: putting objects in small bins and getting them out
- Practice going up and down a stool

### **Fine motor:**

- Scribbling with markers and crayons
- Putting stickers on paper

### **Cognitive:**

- Cause and effect exploration: exploring what happens when we push buttons on the toy
- Object permanence – encourage searching for toys that move out of sight

### **Language:**

Simple turn taking: playing games like peek-a-boo and follow the leader

. Combining gestures with words: Showing “more” sign and encouraging saying “more” together with it
