Skills we will be working on:

From 4 to 6 months

- Rolling from back to chest
- grasping toy actively
- playing with rattles
- establishing eye contact
- responding to sound stimulation
- sitting with support

From 6 to 12 months

- standing, holding on
- pulling up self to stand
- begin walking with support
- finding hidden object using one screen
- using pincer grasp
- waving or responding to bye-bye
- playing simple “Peek-a-Boo” game

From 12 to 18 months

- begin using one or two words
- identify and point to pics
- walk independently
- begin using spoon to feed self
