Learning about time:

How does a Toddler measure time?

- Fast time

- ⚡ Time to go outside
- ⚡ Time to have lunch
- ⚡ Time to take a nap
- ⚡ Time to go home

- Slow time

- ⚡ Flowers blooming
- ⚡ Grass is becoming more green
- ⚡ Trees are getting fuller
- ⚡ Friends are growing taller

Our children may not notice things that happen slowly, but they are very aware of things that happen every day, usually around the same time in the day.

They may not know the concept of time and that they eat lunch at 11:00am, but they know and they are aware that after coming inside from the playground, using washroom, and washing their hands, they will be enjoying their yummy meal.



Routines are great to help children understand the passage of time. Try pointing out the big changes in their environment, and see how they begin to observe and take notice.
