#### Skills we will be working on:

Expressive Language skills (3.3)

From 9 to 18 months

- Recognizing named objects and body parts
- Speaking with words and gestures
- Beginning to speak with more words than gestures

#### Problem solving (4.2)

From 6 to 18 months

- Solving problems with actions by trial and error
- Connecting big puzzle pieces together

#### Gross motor (5.1)

- Lifting upper body while lying on the floor
- Rolling from tummy to different sides
- Walking unassisted with wide gait
- Using furniture to pull self to stand
- Reaching and holding with palmar grasp
- Pulling self to stand up
